**Frustrated with Gun Legislation - Filmmaker Fights Back**

**1<sup>st</sup> Film: "The 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment - Let's Take it Back"**

New Jersey based USAF Veteran launches independent film series to combat the mainstream media's anti- 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment narrative. His main work is titled "The 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment - Let's Take it Back" and features 41 average American citizens who volunteered their time to express their opinions. The short film crosses political, racial, and socio-economic lines and shows how unity can be achieved when it comes to a basic civil right. The film gives a voice to Americans who support Gun Rights, an enormous demographic – ignored by mainstream media.

The film's writer/director, Anthony Smith states: "Leftist media and politicians from both sides have worked tirelessly to demonize a Civil Right that belongs to every American; I will make my best effort to humanize it at an equal level." The project was filmed in NJ at the Union Hill Gun Club and Gun for Hire range.

The film, initially launched in March of 2020, was overshadowed by COVID. It was quickly buried by YouTube algorithms as well, and Anthony was locked out of his account. On this round it will be re-launched on the following platforms in an attempt to circumvent corporate anti-civil rights censorship: Vimeo, Rumble, Full30, GunStreamer, GunTube, UGETube, D.tube, Dailymotion, and Bitchute.

The inspiration for the effort behind this re-launch comes from the court case regarding Kyle Rittenhouse. The case uncovered a transparent anti-gun rights propaganda effort that spanned from media and our legal system, all the way up to POTUS.

The film series is designed to transmit a positive message about Civil Rights that will reach average Americans through an organic grass roots sharing effort. It took 5 months to film and was created with the following intent:

- Put human faces to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment and Civil Rights
- Encourage Americans to take possession of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment - they are our rights, and belong to the people
- Make the statement that now is the time to take those rights back, because they are threatened like never before
- Leave the audience with the question: "How do we take our rights back?"

The short film was independently conceived, written, filmed, edited, and produced by Smith and is designed to leave people asking the question of "How do we take our rights back?" Smith goes on to offer his proposed solutions to the question via the film project's website: <https://2aproductions.com/solution>

He states: "We must open up discussion on how to guarantee that every American has equal civil rights in all 50 states from birth until death. The constant struggle for our own basic rights, against a government that we finance with our tax dollars - must come to an end. We must redefine the function of government.
